Message To Our Donors

Dear all,

Our sincere apologies for not publishing the ECT's newsletter No. 8 for some time. Covid19 has made it impossible for our Founder Members to return to our Alma Mater to check on the status of our projects. This impacted both our monitoring process and our ability to bring in new projects as planned. However, normality is back now and the schools have been reopened without any further disruption. ECT will aim to continue with their progress. ECT was formed in 2015, and it was inaugurated by Hon Mr Akila Viraj Kariyawaasam Minister of Education (2015-2019) at our historical Romaine Hall in 2016. Since 2016 many life members have been enrolled, and a few high-profile old boys & Australian, Canadian OBAs have also donated thousands of pounds and dollars to improve the education at our alma mater.

We implemented many projects to improve the standard of education, starting with Grade 1 to Grade 12. Employed an English teacher (sponsored by a past president of COBA) to teach basic English to grades 1 & 2. We employed a teacher for computing for beginners and established a computer room and installed a digital board in Primary that allows the projection of words, pictures, and even videos on to screen so that youngsters could follow it easily. These can be used for individual students, whole groups, or the entire class. It allows the teacher to present the conceptual data insights and other information.

ECT's 7 years of hard work finally paid off, and at last, Central produced one of the best results in recent times at the A/Level 2021 examinations. Many students were sponsored financially by ECT donors, which allowed them to attend extra classes. Many students appreciated ECT's initiatives for the past 7 years, which brought the best out of them.

Our recent A/L's results have been a great achievement; however, the GCSE O/L's results have not lived up to our expectations. This is due to the disruptive school terms due to COVID 19, the unstable political situation, and the lack of fuel for transporting the kids to school. We could have achieved more if we had followed what we initially planned. This clearly shows us that we should have a better intake from primary and grade 6 to achieve a great level of success in the coming years rather than going for a quick fix. We always believe better intake from an early age would counter such an issue. In the last three years we have had a tremendous success by introducing scholarship payments, which are sponsored by the Australia OBA. However there must be a system in place within school management to ensure that these kids are coached and monitored efficiently by the school. This shouldn't be compromised by any other Old boys or Organisations. Our school must take a huge responsibility and deliver on what we promised when these kids are signed up. There were cases where our school unable to retain some of the kids who had joined. This is part of the reason that we had to put our activities on hold until we create an environment and facilities for these kids and their parents to be comfortable with. This should be implemented by the school with all concerned parties. We are aiming to revive this process after a few years of COVID-19 and will have a dialogue with the principal in due course to make sure the system is in place. We can't simply buy success by wasting our resources unless we streamline regular progress and monitor all students in the school.

Finally, we welcome our old boys and other organisations that have taken ECT's lead and decided to support uplifting the educational standards at JCC. However, we all have a responsibility to our donors and members not to disrupt the ongoing projects that have been in place for the past seven years. We feel that giving exorbitant financial incentives to the students would create more issues amongst teachers and students. There were cases where some students were receiving the funds from more than one organisation and this is clearly disrupting the existing setup in place for many years. We urge all concerned parties to be more realistic and prudent when it comes to making their donations to students. A collective approach is the best way to success!





Update on "Edu Care Trust e-Learning Centre"

This has been on ECT's to do list for the past four years since we had a detailed discussion with Dr Ethirveerasingham's team (e-kalvi) back in 2018. This has never materialised for many reasons, one of them being lack of funds.

We have always been very clear from the start that any projects ECT initiates are with the cooperation of our principal and his management team so that they can make sure they have enough resources to continue any given project for the benefit of our students. This is not forthcoming from the school.

We are extremely disappointed with the progress made in completing the e-learning centre. This is due to the lack of documents and study materials available at school for us to upload on the web portal. This has been a very tough task, and finally we have decided to work with third party providers to gather all syllabus modules, notes, and multiple questions at a considerable cost to fully update the website before its launch.

We delivered 35 used laptops from the UK, set up internet in the e-Learning centre assigned to us for this project, and plan to buy a smart board once our e-Learning centre is operationally successful. This is to make sure that all equipment is fully utilised once it's installed. You can see from the images that students have already started using the facility, and we expect the e-Learning Centre website will be ready and operational by January 2023.

Objectives:

1. Allow all Year 10, O/L, and A/Level students to use this facility during and after school and provide them with access to a vast array of online learning materials from third-party websites as well as our own. We will gradually introduce these facilities to other groups of students as well.
2. Focusing on those students who are achieving below pass marks and giving them extra teaching after school and weekends. This includes customised online multiple-choice questions and a special group session led by a dedicated teacher.


Primary School Activities

JCC Edu Care Trust (ECT) – Active Projects! - 2022

Primary School

1. Year 1 & 2 English elocution classes – (since Jan 2017)
2. Year 3, 4 & 5 paper classes (preparation/ guidance for scholarship exam) – (since Jan 2016), funded by Canada OBA since Jan 2018.
3. Year 1 - 5 computer classes – (since Jan 2016)
4. Year 3 - 5 chess club - (since Jan 2017)
5. Martial arts at Primary School – (since May 2018)
6. Special classes (evening) for year 5 scholarship students

Upper School

1. Scholarship award for Year 6 (9 students), payable £1000 (since Jan 2022)
2. Scholarship award for Year 7 (13 students), payable 1000 RS per month (since Jan 2021)
3. Scholarship award for Year 8 (14 students), payable 1000 RS per month (since Jan 2020)
4. Scholarship award for Year 9 (21 students), payable 1000 RS per month (since Jan 2019)
5. Scholarship award for Year 10 (19 students), payable 1500 RS per month (since Jan 2018)
6. Scholarship award for Year 11 (15 students), payable 3000 RS per month (since Jan 2017)
7. **Chance to succeed** – This is to give an opportunity to those who have failed their year 5 scholarship exam. Students must achieve at least 140 – 155 marks in their scholarship exam. Sponsored by Australia OBA from Jan 2018.

Financial reward for Year 6 – n/a

Financial reward for Year 7, 8 & 9 (30 students), payable 600 RS per month (since Jan 2019 & 2020) and funded by 1986 A/L batch.

Financial reward for Year 7 (41 students), payable 600 RS per month (since Jan 2021) and funded by Australia OBA.

Financial reward for Year 9 (47 students), payable 600 RS per month (since Jan 2019) and funded by Australia OBA.

Financial reward for Year 10 (5 students), payable 600 RS per month (since Jan 2018) and funded by Australia OBA.

8. **Aim high** – for O/L students 2018; this is for selective higher achieving students whom we are targeting 9A's in their O/L exam. Students in this scheme all receive group sessions before and after school on all 9 subjects since May 2018. However, this has been stopped due to lack of support.

Others

1. Administrator – 20,000 per month since 2018, funded Australia OBA
2. 40 laptops have been donated for e-learning center, expect to be completed within few months.
3. Scholarship payments have been increased to 1000 RS for year 6-9, 1500 RS for year 10 and 3000 RS for O/L students since Jan 2022 due to the current financial crisis.
